34 Countries and nationalities

Aim To teach the names of some common countries and nationalities.

Preparation Copy the handout on page 113 – one copy per student.

(Optional) Take in some magazine photos of people from different countries.

Introduction (5 minutes)

Introduce the subject by saying to the students that foreigners often call people living in Britain or the UK English and think that everyone lives in England. But that's not really true. Draw a rough map of the UK and explain that the UK is made up of four countries, not one. See if the students know the other countries, namely Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. Write them on the map. Then write the following on the board:

I live in ... England I'm ... English

Scotland Wales

Northern Ireland

Elicit the missing nationalities (Scottish, Welsh and Northern Irish). Point out that people from all these countries are also British. Practise saying the names of the countries chorally. Finally, ask one or two students about themselves, for example: What about you, Kurt? Where do you live? What nationality are you? etc. Alternative introduction Hold up the photographs you have brought with you one by one and ask the class if they can guess what nationality the person is. Why did they think the person was (Swedish)? Was it the clothes, skin/hair colour, etc.? Then go on to the above table about the four nationalities in the UK.

Presentation (15 minutes)

Activity A Give students the handout. Let them work in pairs to fill it in. When they have finished, write the following on the board:

A: Are you Swedish?

B: No, I'm French. I come from France. Get them to practise similar dialogues in pairs. choosing other nationalities from the ones in the table.

Practice (20 minutes)

Activity B This is a crossword dictation. The students can either work alone or in pairs. Give out copies of the crossword and tell the students you are going to read out clues to help them to fill in the crossword. All the answers are either a country or a nationality. Read out the following clues, allowing time for them to fill in the answers. (You can read each clue twice.)

Let's start with 8 Across: Honda, Yamaha and Canon are all __(bleep!)__ companies.

Next, 9 Down: Elvis Presley was a famous __(bleep!)__ pop

10 Across: Flamenco is a traditional dance in this country.

13 Across: Beethoven and Bach were famous __(bleep!)__

Finally, 12 Down: People in this country eat a lot of curry.

Check orally.

Conclusion (10 minutes)

Activity C This is a fun activity. The students complete the sentences then compare their answers with a partner.

Homework

The students can write a short paragraph about the country they live in.
